- 1. You must be a Painter or Drywall Finisher Journeyperson.
- 2. You must be a member in good standing for a full current program year to be eligible for a prize ticket(s).
- 3. Working hours & STAR credit requirements to qualify for prize drawing;
 - 800 hours are needed to qualify for the Tier I prize drawing.

300 hours are needed to qualify for the Tier II prize drawing.
